Regular Red

2022 The Hidden Cove Merlot – Lodi, California (\$12.99)

Aromas of blackberries, plum and herbs, velvety texture with notes of cherries, clove and vanilla. Medium-bodied with a smooth finish.

2024 Franco Serra Dolcetto d'Alba – Piedmont, Italy (\$18.99)

Ruby red color. Sweet spice, chocolate and red fruit aromas with hints of tobacco. Medium bodied and dry with ripe red fruit, light tannins and well-balanced acidity.

2019 Ribeiro Santo Tinto – Dao, Portugal (\$14.99)

Medium ruby color. Red fruits aroma combined with some spices like black pepper. A fresh and young wine, true to terroir, with structure and exuberant finish. It's versatile and easy to drink on any occasion. Pairs perfectly with roasted meat dishes, dried nuts, mushroom and soft cheeses

2020 Riporta Nero d'Avola – Sicily, Italy (\$16.99)

A deep and brilliant red wine with purplish highlights. It has elaborated aromas with hints of spices (such as licorice and cloves), prune, cherry, blackberry, and blackcurrant. Best served with first courses, barbecued meats, and seasoned cheese.

2021 Pietramaggio Seta – Tuscany, Italy (\$17.99)

Easy-going and delicious wine packed with aromas of red berries. Supple, sweet, and youthful all the while maintaining great structure and fresh acidity. A versatile wine that pairs with a variety of dishes. Try with pizza, grilled meats, BBQ, hearty pastas or cheeses.

2023 Olivares Altos de la Hoya Monastrell – Jumilla, Spain (\$16.99)

Deep ruby. Ripe, powerful scents of red and dark fruits, minerals and spices. Finishes fresh and long, with a repeating dark fruit note.

Regular White

2023 Rebellious Sauvignon Blanc – California (\$15.99)

This crisp and refreshing Sauvignon Blanc features notes of tropical fruit, melon, citrus and green apple. Vibrant acidity and beautiful minerality complete the wine profile, making an exceptionally balanced wine with a rich, long mouthfeel. Excellent on its own as an aperitif, it also pairs well with salads, fruit, green vegetables, light white fish dishes and even stronger flavors like asparagus.

2024 Ruffino Orvieto Classico – Umbria, Italy (\$12.99)

Refreshing and enjoyable aromas, with distinctive citrus and apple nuances accompanied by delicate floral notes. The palate is upbeat with delicate mineral notes. The almond finish is harmonious and balanced.

2023 Casa Silva 1912 Vines Sauvignon Gris – Colchagua, Chile (\$18.99)

A straw yellow wine of low intensity, aromas of yellow lemon, white pear, green melon, fresh apricots, pineapple and lemon blossom. The palate is medium-high acidity, fresh, with good volume, tropical and ripe citrus flavors.

2024 Maison de Riviere Sauvignon Blanc Reserve – France (\$14.99)

This is a dry, crisp white wine from France. It is noted for its savory character and citrus and stone fruit flavors, with high acidity and a lingering finish. Serve this wine with seafood pastas or roasted chicken.

2023 Gustav Adolf Schmitt Riesling Spatlese – Rheinhessen, Germany (\$15.99)

This Riesling Spatlese displays aromas and flavours of candied pears and apples. Lush, rich and expressive, this wine exhibits intense depth of fruit and a long flavourful finish. This medium bodied wine is very enjoyable with spicy cuisine, but also with aged blue cheese. It goes well with sweet desserts or can be enjoyed on its own.

2023 Uvaciaccia Vitto – Salento, Italy (\$14.99)

Medium-acidity, which contributes to an invigorating mouthfeel. Prominent stone fruit intensity with notes of honey and citrus blossom that dances on the palate with every sip.

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Premium Red

2023 Glassblower Cabernet Sauvignon – Napa Valley, California (\$28.99)

This classic Cabernet Sauvignon is bold and structured. Aromas of deep black fruit lead to flavors of juicy plum, blackberry and baking spice. This wine is full-bodied and excellently balanced, it's finish persistent and elegant.

2021 Chateau Rocher Gardat – Bordeaux, France (\$23.99)

Brilliant ruby red. This has a modern nose with toasty oak, across some graphite and dark plums with notes of red fruit. The Palate has juicy resolve with a sleek, flesh bed of succulent tannins and evolves into fruity

2023 Josetta Saffirio Langhe Nebbiolo – Piedmont, Italy (\$33.99)

A full-bodied wine, packed with flavours of sour cherry, raspberry, and roses with earthy notes on the finish. This Nebbiolo pairs well with second courses of red or braised meat, together with mature cheeses.

2018 Ribeiro Santo Tinto Reserva – Dao, Portugal (\$21.99)

The body is medium, offering a balanced and smooth texture that elegantly showcases the fruit-forward characteristics. The acidity is vibrant, adding a refreshing liveliness to the overall tasting experience. With a well-rounded fruit intensity and notable yet approachable tannins, this wine delivers a delightful dry finish that lingers pleasantly on the palate.

2022 Franco Serra Barbaresco – Piedmont, Italy (\$39.99)

Pale red brick color. Very aromatic with notes of dried flowers, violets and cherries. Full-bodied and dry, but elegant with plump red fruit balanced by chewy tannins and bright acidity. Pair with rich, meaty dishes like braised short ribs and stews. Makes for a nice complement to duck breast or even sausage-topped pizza!

2023 Casa Silva Carmenere Los Lingues Vineyard – Colchagua Valley, Chile (\$25.99)

Deep ruby with a violet rim. On the nose, intense, with notes of ripe black fruits with hints of wild forest fruits. On the palate, good balance between fruit and oak, good structure, powerful, sweet and round tannins, and notes of boysenberries and hints of tobacco. Excellent finish. This Carmenere will accompany a surprisingly broad range of dishes.

Premium Mix

2024 Deux Roches Macon-Villages Tradition – Burgundy, France (\$25.99)

This cuvee expresses the full spirit of a Maconnais Chardonnay: floral richness and the tasty flavour of yellow fruits such as peach and apricot. Drink as an aperitif with fresh goat cheese or a crispy chicken bao.

2024 Palladino Gavi del Comune di Gavi – Piedmont, Italy (\$32.99)

Made exclusively from Cortese grapes grown within the Comune of Gavi, it is a fresh and very drinkable wine. The bouquet is fruity and floral with mineral notes, pleasantly dry flavours, with an elegant, well-balanced acidity and a delicate almond finale. Pair this wine with mild cheeses or with light appetizers and fish dishes.

2020 Clos Centeilles Le Mosaïque – Siran, France (\$36.99)

The grey, pink, and white grapes together create a veritable aromatic rainbow composed of citrus, dried herbs, yellow fruits, and white flowers, all bound together by a refreshing minerality. Its vibrancy and character will sweep you away on a captivating and surprising journey.

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
