Regular Red

2022 Borgata Calpolicella Classico – Valpolicella, Italy (\$18.99)

Brilliant ruby-red color. The bouquet is pleasant and fruity, with notes of cherry and red fruits. The palate is fresh, vibrant and balanced. Fruity and clean finish.

2021 Grandeur Red Blend – Monterey County, California (\$12.99)

A full-bodied blend with succulent notes of tart blackberry, elderberry, and juicy plum, while warm hints of ripe fig and vanilla bean waft from the glass. Structured tannins bring balance as well as complement the lingering sweetness from French oak.

2023 Sao Miguel do Sul – Alentejo, Portugal (\$15.99)

This wine is ruby in color, with violet hints. Intense aromas of red and black forest fruits, harmoniously combined with floral and toasted notes. The palate is very juicy and fruity, with nice acidity and smooth tannins.

2023 Chateau Terrebert Cotes du Marmandais – France (\$15.99)

With a dark garnet colour this vintage diffuses intense and deep aromas of red currant and black currant balanced with light spicy notes. In the mouth the initial subtleties reveal a concentrated and fleshy wine matching the spicy notes of malbec.

NV Pebble Lane Cabernet Sauvignon – California (\$13.99)

Aromas of plum, blackberry, mocha and smoky oak followed by rich flavors of black fruit and cassis, with a hint of fresh herbs. Approachable tannins and a round, full body lead to a structured, but soft, lingering finish. Pair with grilled steaks or other hearty dishes.

2023 Valderiz Valdehermoso Joven – Ribera del Duero, Spain (\$17.99)

Bright cherry with lively fruit; fresh and elegant with soft tannins and a long and spicy finish.

Regular White

2024 Segno Librandi Ciro Bianco – Calabria, Italy (\$14.99)

Brilliant lemon-green in color, aromas of peaches and citrus fruits complement undertones of herbs and flowers. On the palate, zesty acidity and a long finish showcase this wine's subtle hints of toasted almonds and macadamia nuts.

2023 Slow Press Sauvignon Blanc – California (\$14.99)

This California Sauvignon Blanc is bursting with crisp, refreshing notes of citrus and pear. A slow winemaking process brings out the fullest flavors and reveals a bright, fruit-forward wine.

2024 Chateau La Grande Metairie – Bordeaux, France (\$16.99)

This light wine, with delicate lemon notes on both the nose and the palate, combines suppleness, a rich texture, and a lingering fruity finish in perfect balance.

2025 Luna Nuda Pinot Grigio – Cortina, Italy (\$16.99)

Bright, crisp flavors of golden delicious apple and citrus flow through this dry, easy-drinking white, with just a hint of alpine air and minerality — flavors that come straight from growing in Italy's northernmost wine region. Crisp, clean, and refreshing and perfect for any occasion.

2024 Protea Sauvignon Blanc – Western Cape, South Africa (\$16.99)

Aromas of tangy passionfruit, lime, and nectarine meld with notes of fresh fruit salad, with a lively, crisp palate to match. A vibrant acidity is complemented by a subtle hint of gravel and flint, adding layers of complexity and a dry, mineral edge to the mouthfeel, and with a deliciously dry, lemon-zest finish.

2025 Broadbent Gruner Veltliner – Weinland, Austria (\$19.99)

This wine offers delicate aromas of fresh green apple, complemented by flavors of lemon, lime, and peach. The wine boasts a solid fruit core, rich in finesse, with a beautiful length and mineral tones. Its elegant and delicious profile makes it an ideal companion for seafood, white meats, light salads, or simply enjoyed on its own as a refreshing summer wine.

Regular Mix

2024 Segno Librandi Ciro Bianco – Calabria, Italy (\$14.99)

Premium Red

2022 Palazzo Roddo di Montalcino – Montalcino, Italy (\$22.99)

This wine displays aromas of baked cherries, red plums, sweet spices and cocoa. Medium-bodied with firm, slightly coarse tannins and juicy red fruit underneath. Spiced and earthy.

2022 Chateau de Bouillerot – Bordeaux, France (\$28.99)

The nose is particularly expressive with hints of blackberry and cherry, followed by woody tones. On the palate it is pleasantly fine with balanced and well-integrated tannins. A wine with a clear personality, with good aging potential.

2024 Fournier Pinot Noir – France (\$25.99)

Suave and polished in style, this Pinot offers ripe cherry and blackberry fruit, with silky tannins and a touch of spice. The structure is light but balanced, finishing with moderate length and good poise.

2023 Bodega Lanzaga Corriente – Rioja, Spain (\$25.99)

Surprisingly smooth, aromatic, and full of ripe berry fruit, subtle spice, and earthy tannins. Easy to enjoy on its own, but even better with richer dishes.

2023 Alpha Estate Xinomavro Hedgehog – Florina, Greece (\$32.99)

Complex bouquet of red berries, leather and spices (vanilla, pepper, clove), with hints of ripe blackberry. Full mouth, rounded tannins, balanced acidity and well-integrated wood tones. Long aftertaste with intense quince aroma.

2019 Constitution Road Shiraz – Robertson, South Africa (\$39.99)

This opens with aromatic blueberry and cherry that carries hints of nutmeg. The palate shows flavors of candied berries and spices, finishing with notes of bell pepper. It's a lean, accessible Shiraz.

Premium Mix

2024 Damien Martin Macon-Verze – Burgundy, France (\$32.99)

Citrus and stone, generous but crisp. Pair Mconnais whites with richly textured, but uncomplicated flavors. Try fettuccine tossed in a lemon cream sauce, garlic-butter cod or chicken tacos with a lime crema.

2021 Frey-Sohler Rittersberg Pinot Gris – Alsace, France (\$28.99)

Elegant yellow-gold.pleasant bouquet, slightly smoky,rich, full-bodied and with a long finish, its complex aroma is reminiscent of woodland.

2021 Croci Campedello – Castell' Arquato, Italy (\$24.99)

This blend offers a crisp, fruit-forward profile, making it an ideal choice for both casual and formal occasions. Its elegant balance of acidity and fruit flavors is a hallmark of the Colli Piacentini terroir.

2022 Palazzo Roddo di Montalcino – Montalcino, Italy (\$22.99)

This wine displays aromas of baked cherries, red plums, sweet spices and cocoa. Medium-bodied with firm, slightly coarse tannins and juicy red fruit underneath. Spiced and earthy.

2022 Chateau de Bouillerot – Bordeaux, France (\$28.99)
